STATUTE

Art. 1: Purpose. GUG (Officials Group) is a technical central body of FIN which operates through a network; it is functionally independent for the achievement of its own istitutional intents. Its purpose is to recruit, organize and regulate the FIN Officials and to provide through them the exact application of technical regulation and related Federal rules.








Art.27 Incompatibility. According to Art, 21 of the Statute, the title of Officials for competitions is incompatible with any federal role, other than mere consultant or Director of the sport clubs or affiliated entities. No exception is admitted by the Federal Bureau for such incompatibilities. Officials can not be registered as athletes except for the Master area.

















